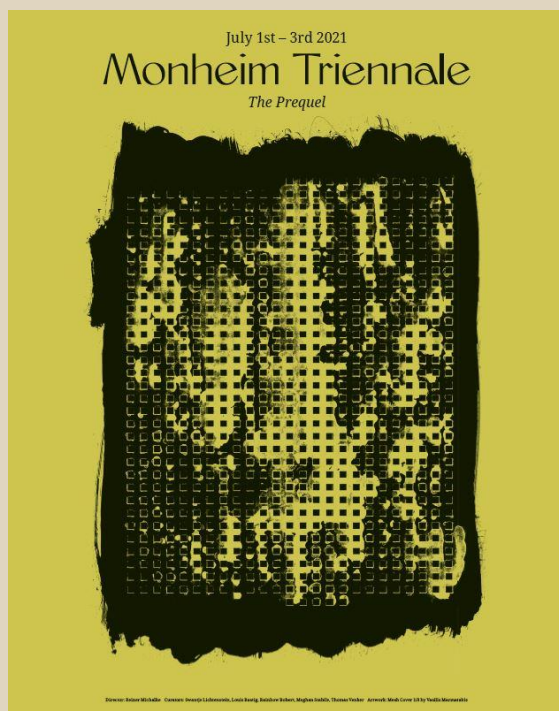
The Prequel July 1st – 3rd 2021
